The Trustees of the Southern California Drug Benefit Fund approved coverage for the H1N1 vaccine as part of the 2010 Preventive Care Benefit for Active Participants eligible for benefits under the Indemnity Medical Plan.

Effective January 1, 2010 and through December 31, 2010, the Drug Benefit Fund will reimburse 100% of the cost of the H1N1 vaccine under the Drug Fund's Preventive Care Benefit for active participants covered under the Indemnity Medical Plan.
